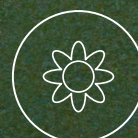

Some objects move even while standing still. Veloce, the new tapware collection from Zucchetti, is one of them. Designed by the international studio Yabu Pushelberg, the collection looks back to the 1930s, to an era of refined automobiles and confident architectural geometry, and translates that sense of motion into brass.

The result is a family of mixers with real presence. Soft, continuous silhouettes recall the controls and grips of a vintage car, while the broader form holds the rigour of fine architecture. Offered in single-lever and two-handle versions and a generous range of finishes, Veloce is made for spaces that reward a second look: luxury homes, considered hotels, rooms designed to last. It is a fitting cover for an issue about designing beautifully for the long run.

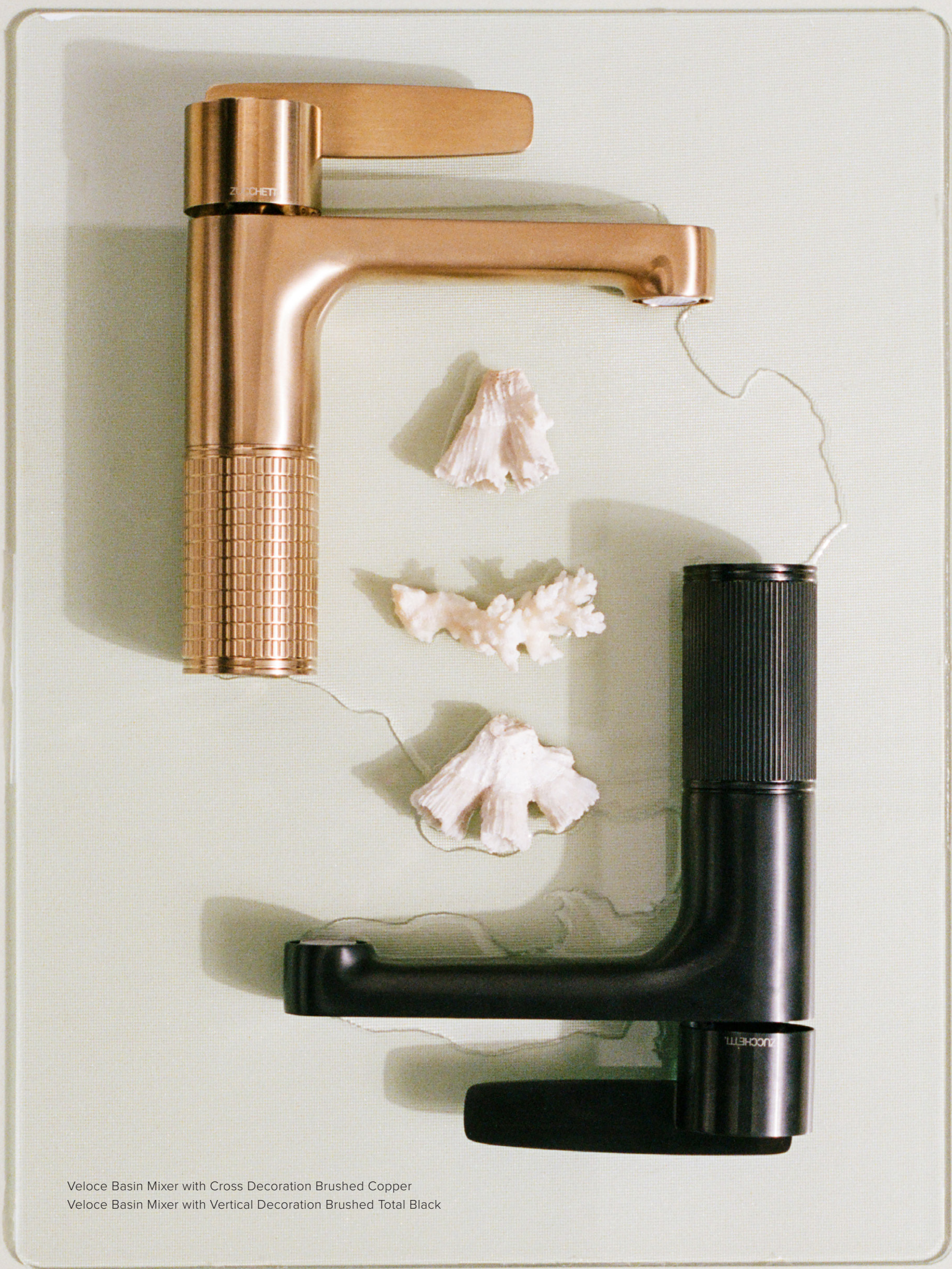

Salone del Mobile. Milano

At the 2026 Milan Design Week, the bathroom emerged as one of the design industry's most considered spaces. Across six days at Fiera Milano Rho and showrooms throughout the city, our brands presented work shaped by materiality, longevity and quiet restraint. Here are the moments that stood out.

Alice

Alice Ceramica presented ATTRAVERSO, a new exhibition concept staged at Salone del Mobile and the Brera Design District. Within a permeable grid of vertical elements, ceramic volumes were released from twodimensionality and allowed to float, inviting visitors to walk through the bathroom rather than past it.



Zucchetti

Zucchetti unveiled OCTO X by David Lopez Quincoces at its new Corso Venezia showroom. The original Octo collection reworked in stainless steel, OCTO X retains the same form and proportions while introducing a different material resonance. A study in how matter can quietly reframe an object's identity.

Ceramica Flaminia introduced Hasu, a new washbasin by Giulio Iacchetti inspired by the lotus flower. Available as a countertop or freestanding piece, in warm new tones of Castagno, Miele and Tundra. Basin and column can be paired in different colours, creating customisable compositions of quiet elegance.



Zuccheti Bar 59

Also on display, Bar 59, the modular shower system designed by Matteo Fiorini with Studio Lys. Flat plates set the layout and simplify installation, while cylindrical elements sit where they are wanted. Five jets, from a soft Rain to a linear Blade, combine and swap to suit the moment. We have been pairing it with the new Veloce collection.

CONTINUING THE LEGACY





Set within Parnell’s historic precinct and bordered by the leafy expanse of Auckland Domain, The Foundation has, in just a few short years, established itself as the benchmark for luxury retirement living in New Zealand.

Inspired by the redevelopment of Chelsea Barracks in London’s Belgravia, the architecture draws on European Jura limestone, deep façade relief and classical proportions, in a sympathetic dialogue with the heritage buildings that frame the site.

Designed by Peddlethorp, with interiors by Stewart Harris of Macintosh Harris, Abbott Residences carries forward the architectural language established by Nathan Residences while expressing its own quiet character. Classic design detailing, executed with contemporary precision.

Robertson Bathware were proud to play a role in translating this design intent into of every kitchen, laundry and bathroom across the building. Working closely with the design team, we curated a suite of fittings that balance Italian craft, ergonomic ease and quiet refinement, qualities that sit at the heart of life at The Foundation.

Throughout the kitchens and sculleries, Nobili’s Mania Collection has been specified, with matching mixers extending into the laundries.

Established in 1954 in Borgomanero, Nobili is one of Italy’s most respected tapware manufacturers, with a 100% Italian production cycle and seven decades of engineering heritage. The Mania Collection brings together ergonomics, durable Widd cartridge technology and contemporary look, offering residents effortless daily use.

In the bathrooms, tapware from Zucchetti’s Pan Collection has been featured. Founded in 1929 in Valduggia, Piedmont, Zucchetti has been guided by three generations of the Zucchetti family and remains one of Italy’s most influential design-led tapware houses. Pan, by Milanese duo Ludovica + Roberto Palomba, draws its inspiration from nature, with the body, spout and lever flowing together as if grafted, like the trunk of a tree. The result is a sculptural softness; a fitting expression for spaces designed to age beautifully alongside their residents.

The showers across Abbott Residences are anchored by the Elementi One Touch Square 2 Function Thermostatic Mixer in Brushed Nickel, a thoughtful specification for a retirement context. With built-in scald protection that limits hot water to 38°C, single-touch control of flow and mode, and precise temperature regulation, it brings together safety, simplicity and a contemporary visual language. Practical considerations, expressed with no compromise on style.

Abbott Residences is a confident next chapter in the unfolding story of The Foundation. Peddlethorp’s careful master planning, Macintosh Harris’s considered interiors, and a curated suite of fittings from Robertson Bathware have come together in a building that honours its historic precinct while quietly raising the bar for what retirement living in New Zealand can be.

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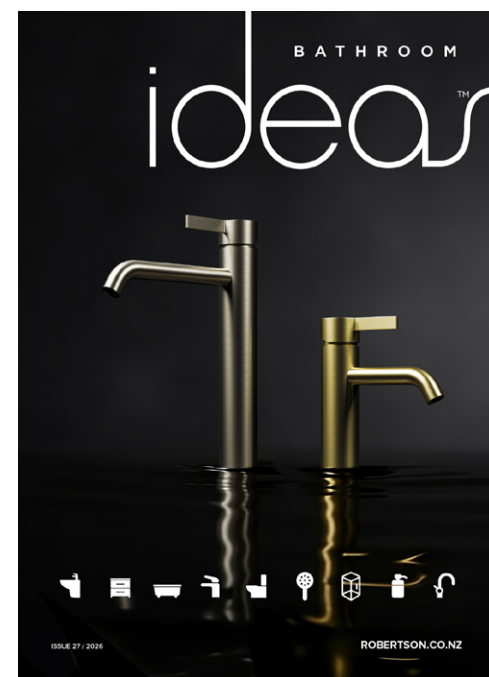
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
